Cyberport Announces Collaboration with Major Institutions to Promote the Popularization of Web3 Technology at FinTech Week

Showcases Applications of Central Bank Digital Currency and Green Finance

Hong Kong, 2 November 2023 – Organized by InvestHK, the flagship event of the Hong Kong FinTech industry, "**The 8th Hong Kong FinTech Week**" started its main conference today. As a partner of Hong Kong FinTech Week, Cyberport leads 16 start-ups in participation, aligning with this year's theme "**Redefining FinTech**", showcasing the leading FinTech solutions of start-ups and network members, and jointly exploring the Central Bank Digital Currency (CBDC), Web3, and Green Finance. At the same time, Cyberport will also cooperate with the members of the Cyberport Technology Network (CTN), Amazon Web Services (AWS), and Ant Group to respectively launch 2 Web3 transformation and support programmes with the aim to promote the popularization of Web3 technology.

Cyberport announced today that it will collaborate with AWS and Polygon Labs, to launch the "Web2 to Web3 Enablement Program" to provide matching services for large enterprises and Web3 technology solutions. Cyberport Technology Network (CTN) member Ant Group also announced that Ant Group Digital Technologies and OceanBase will provide Cyberport community members with a special offer through the "FinTech Week Special Discount" and the "Cloud Database Migration Lab/Sandbox" Programme.

Peter Yan, CEO of Cyberport, said: "I am pleased to see more FinTech enterprises and start-ups involving Web3 and Artificial Intelligence participated in the FinTech Week this year, which includes open banking, tokenization, and green FinTech, reflecting the ongoing development of Web applications and experience in the FinTech area. Cyberport has launched two collaborative programmes with Cyberport Technology Network (CTN) companies. Ant Group will provide Web3 products and supporting services to Cyberport start-ups with a special offer. A dedicated sandbox environment will also be provided through the 'Cloud Database Migration Lab/Sandbox' Programme to promote digital transformation. In order to promote the wider application of Web3 technology and help Web3 start-ups gain more use cases, Cyberport is collaborating with AWS and Polygon Labs to launch the "Web2 to Web3 Enablement Program", allowing large enterprises to have access to more Web3 solutions and promote their transformation and product upgrades.

The Programme recruits a number of large enterprises from the transportation, retail, F&B and

other industries to participate. They will be matched with the services provided by Web3 start-ups based on their needs.

AWS will provide AWS cloud resources to large enterprises and recommend suitable Web3 solutions; Polygon Labs will provide access to blockchain technical expertise for empowering application of Web3 technology. In addition, start-ups participating in the Programme will have the opportunity to have one-on-one consultations with AWS or Polygon Labs representatives to further discuss business development and performance improvement suggestions. Cyberport, AWS and Polygon Labs will promote the Programme and recruit suitable large enterprises and start-ups to participate, helping large enterprises test and launch new Web3 campaigns and proof of concepts under 60 days. Exploring Central Bank Digital Currency and the Development of Green Finance

During the main forum of the Hong Kong FinTech Week on 2-3 November 2023, Cyberport showcased breakthrough innovative solutions in the fields of open banking, RegTech, tokenization of real-world assets, green FinTech, InsurTech, and WealthTech, by a total of 16 start-ups from the Cyberport community.

Cyberport has been working with Hang Seng Bank, a member of the Cyberport Enterprise Network (CEN) to promote the financial technology ecosystem. This year, Hang Seng Bank showcased the technical application of Central Bank Digital Currency (CBDC) at the Hong Kong FinTech Week, allowing attendees to experience first-hand the roles of merchants and customers in the creation and use of CBDC tokens. The CBDC application would demonstrate how to use smart contracts to restrict the use of tokens, ensuring the safety of both parties and demonstrating the advanced features of blockchain technology.

Cyberport Technology Network (CTN) member Ant Group also presented OceanBase, its self-developed native distributed database and ZAN Web3 technical solutions from Ant Group Digital Technologies. OceanBase brings financial-grade high availability on commodity servers and addresses scalability, ease of use, and high-cost challenges in database. Powered by

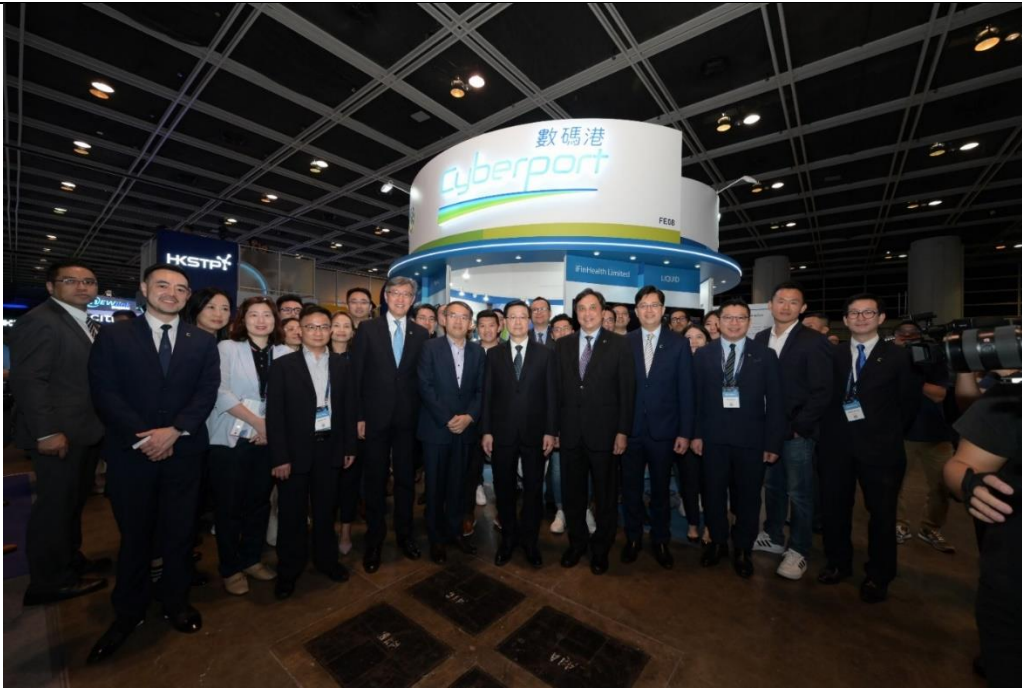
AntChain Open Labs, ZAN provides comprehensive technical products and services for corporates and developers, to secure and optimize Web3 applications, platforms and businesses.

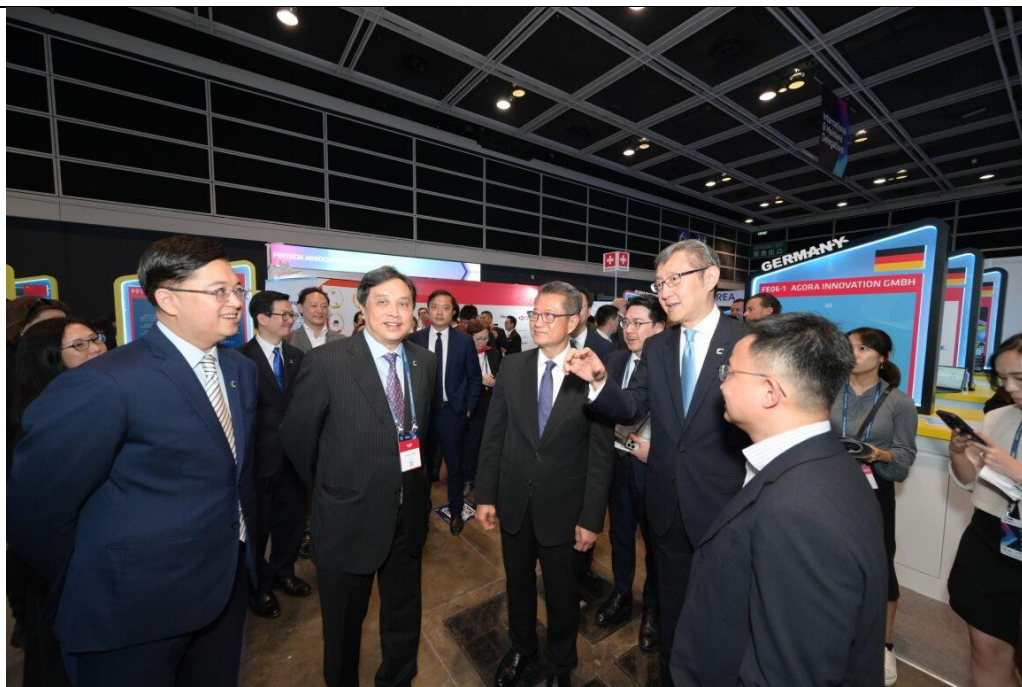

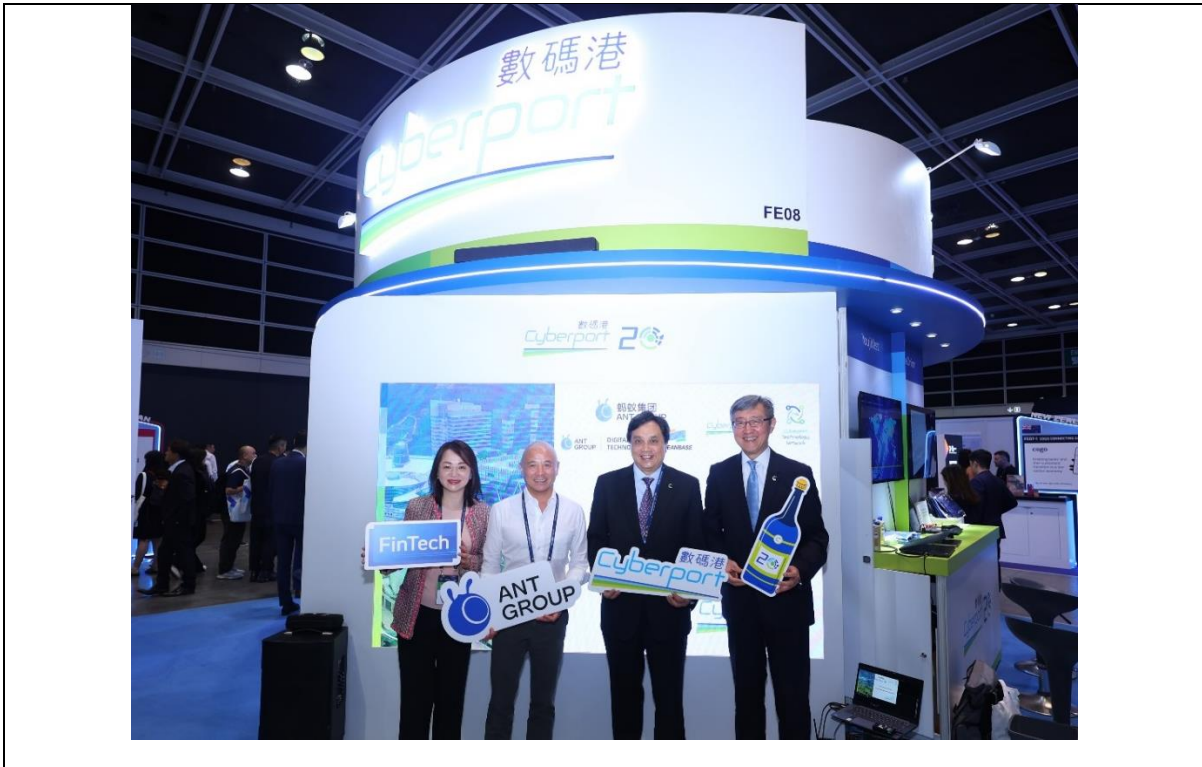

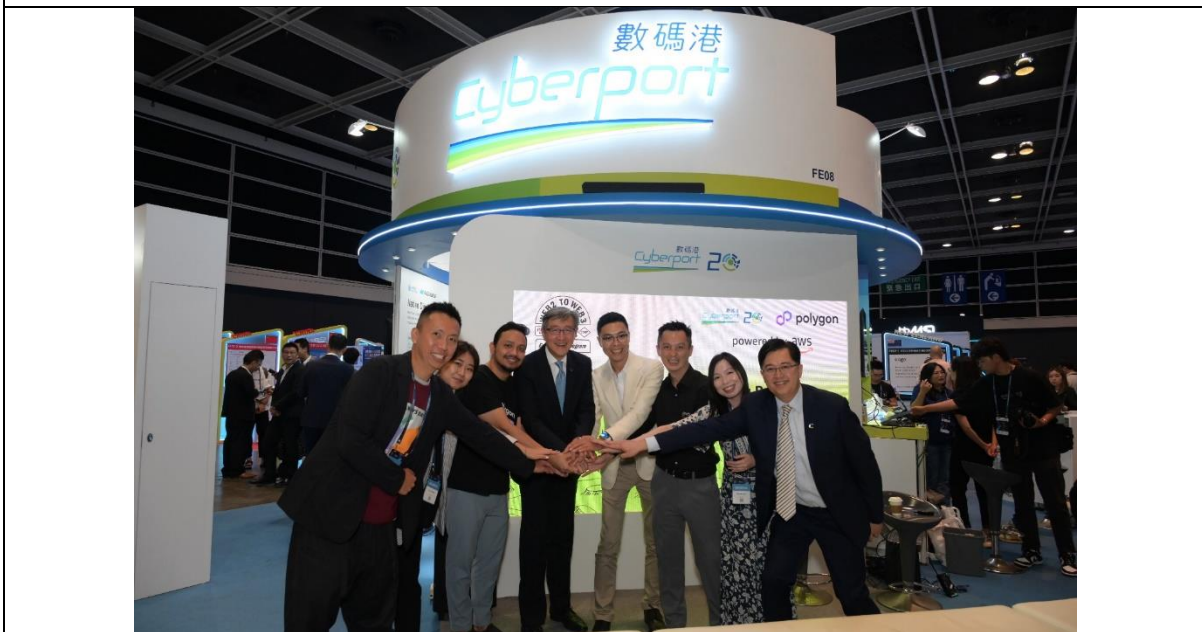
